



## **Summer Program 2017**

This year's Summer Program will run the following weeks:

### **June 19th – July 28th**

-there will be no classes on Tuesday, July 4th

On the first day of the first week for which your child is enrolled, you will need to check in at the registration table that will be set up in the hallway leading to the entrance of the preschool. When you check in, you will be told which color door classroom your child is assigned to. Generally, we try to keep children enrolled in multiple weeks in the same color door, but, because our enrollment fluctuates from week to week, sometimes changes might be necessary.

You will need to supply the following list of items as soon as possible, and no later than upon the first day your child is enrolled to participate. Submitting the paperwork ahead of time will make for an efficient check-in experience. If you are missing any of the required materials, your child may not participate in the program until they have been submitted: **REQUIRED PAPERWORK**

1. For children with allergies and those who require medications, you will need to supply us with **all** of the prescribed medication in its **original packaging and labeled with prescribed instructions**. We will also need the completed and signed *Emergency Health Care Plan* we provided you. Please contact us if you have *any* questions regarding your child's medications.
2. If we do not have one that is current, we will also need a completed and signed *Early Childhood Health Assessment Record* that reflects the results of a physical exam performed on your child that is dated 8/1/2016 or later. We provided you with this form if we do not already have one for your child that is suitable.
3. A completed *Emergency Contact and Authorization to Pick Up Form* for each child.

### **Seahorse Program – 3 year olds**

This program runs Tuesday, Wednesday & Thursday from 9:00 am - 12:00 pm. Please bring an extra set of clothes in a zip lock bag labeled with your child's name. Children also need to bring their swim suit, towel and water shoes each day as they will play at the water tables. We will supply children with a snack and water to drink each day. Children who participate in our Seahorse Program must be toilet trained. Please do not send them to the program wearing diapers or "Pull-Ups" (absorbent undergarments).

### **Preschool Program - 4 and 5 years olds**

This program runs Monday - Friday from 9:00 am - 1:00 pm. Please bring an extra set of clothes in a zip lock bag labeled with your child's name. Children need to bring their swim suit, towel and water shoes each day, as they will play in the sprinklers. We will supply children with a snack and water to drink each day.

Children need to bring a lunch every day. Please pack their lunch in an insulated lunch box. Please remember that we are a nut/tree nut free school and no foods sent in may contain nuts or be processed in a plant that produces foods with nuts. Due to various food allergies that may be present in the school, it is imperative that all processed food be in the original packaging so that teachers can determine the ingredients.

The doors will open each day at 8:55am. Please remember to apply sunscreen and insect repellent for your child every day at home just prior to coming to the program. If you have questions, please contact us at
